TEAMGYM Junior Cup - 2/5

May 23th 2009, Dornbirn, Austria

Dear friends of gymnastics. Turnsportzentrum Dornbirn cordially invites you to an international TEAMGYM Junior Competition. This meeting is also part 2 (of up to 5) of a newly established European Cup and sanctioned by the Austrian Gymnastics Federation. We are pleased to give you the following information:

1. Date

2. Venue

The competition will take place in Dornbirn, Messehalle 1.

3. Competition rules

We invite all European junior teams. We will use CoP 2004.

- Height of the vaulting table can be 150 cm or 160 cm (men 165 cm)
- Competition is open to all junior teams, age limit is 18 (birth year 1991 and younger)
- Each gymnast is allowed to take part in one category only.

4. Apparatuses/Equipment

Floor: Mats 14 x 20 m supplied by Spieth. Tumbling track supplied by Eurogym. Vaulting tables supplied by Spieth (height between 150 cm and 160 cm, boys 165 cm). Trampettes supplied by Spieth and Eurogym".

5. Judges

Each team is asked to bring a judge (national brevet or higher) at its own cost.

6. Accommodation

We offer a possibility to sleep in a nearby school (the special fee is 15 Euros per day and person including breakfast, you have to bring your own sleeping bags). If you prefer hotel accommodation, you may contact www.dornbirn.at or ask the organizing committee for assistance.

- Definite registration not later than 22nd March 2009.

- Team's name and category (female, male or mixed).
- Judge's name.
- Team's head (person name, phone and e-mail)

Following your provisional registration the OC will inform you about all details for definitive registration."

10. Overall information about the cup

A team may participate in as many competitions as it wants to, from one up to all five. At least two participations are needed to be included in the overall European cup ranking. If a team participates in more than two competitions, the two highest result points count. The cup winner will receive a free week in the great Cesenatico training center in Italy for the whole team! Second place earns the possibility to book a Cesenatico training week 75 % cheaper. Third place gets the possibility to book a Cesenatico week at half price. The competitions of the cup
