about the work within the TRA-TC, the plans for the future and to discuss with them how to develop our sport.
The final invitation and the program for this small conference will be sent mid March 2008.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition format will be in accordance with the UEG Technical Regulations and FIG Code of points in force.

AGE

See FIG Technical Regulations.

Seniors: Minimum 17 years old (born 1991 or older)

Juniors: Minimum 13, maximum 17 years old (born 1995 - 1991)

Gymnasts have the right to participate if they reach the determined age during the year of the competition. It is only possible to participate in one category: either senior or junior.

PROVISIONAL ENTRY

Must be returned to the UEG Secretariat by **28.11.2007**.

DEFINITIVE ENTRY

Must be returned to the UEG Secretariat by **28.01.2008**.

NOMINATIVE ENTRY

Must be returned to the UEG Secretariat by **07.04.2008**.

JUDGES

All participating federations have to nominate at least 1 judge with a valid FIG Brevet for each sport (TRA, TUM and DMT) in which they have competitors. The same judge may judge in the junior and the senior event.

Failure to provide a judge will result in the UEG charging the federation concerned a fine.

All judges must participate in the judges' information meeting.
