### 2.3. Competition Format

This Competition will be held according to the FIG Competition 2022 rules and the FIG Technical Regulations 2022.

**Format Seniors:** 5-4-3 Up to five gymnasts build a team, up to four of them compete for the team at each apparatus, the top three scores per apparatus count for the team results.

**Format Juniors:** 5-4-3 Up to five gymnasts build a team, up to four of them compete for the team at each apparatus, the top three scores per apparatus count for the team results.

All gymnasts of a team are allowed to compete a complete individual all around competition.

### 2.4. Victory Ceremony

Only teams or gymnasts n° 1 to 3 will participate in the victory ceremonies. According to FIG regulations, all the gymnasts have to wear their national tracksuits.

This also includes fully vaccinated or recovered persons.
